If you are a counselor, you will likely be working, living and sleeping in a cabin with campers. You will be responsible for their vell-being, evening programs, behaviour and sitting with them at meals. (Some positions do not require you to sleep in cabins with campers but this is rare.) Your placement confirmation will be available via your Footprints account. Your camp may request you sign a camp specific contract. If this is the case, this overrides your Program Agreement in terms of dates, pocket money and time off policies.
